



## Divine Spiritual Keys – “The Word of Our Testimony”

*And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by **the word of their testimony**; and they loved not their lives unto the death. **Revelation 12:11***

### **PW365 GUIDELINES (Spiritual Keys)**

1. **The importance of discernment** – Test everything in these days – Discernment is a gift of the Holy Spirit that means continual connection through the power of prayer.
2. **Prayer is a dialogue with God.** Prayer without ceasing is communion with God. Communion with God is trusting in Him. This opens up the Bible and all of God’s words not only to our understanding but into our personal walk through life.
3. **SURRENDER IS KEY: First thing we surrender is our own understanding.** For some Believers in Christ much of this will be **confirmation**, for others **revelation** or a little of both; and yet others, new in their walk with Christ it may seem to **defy common sense** may even seem foolish.

*The natural person does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned. **1 Corinthians 2:14***

*So ask and keep on asking, seek and keep on seeking, knock and keep on knocking...**Matthew 7:7***

4. **Our own personal revelation is directly proportional to our surrender** (obedience) to God, through Jesus Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit. We will only be able to see to the degree with which we trust Him each day.
5. **Do NOT BE FOOLED: Our opponent is a Master of deception** – His best lie is one degree from the truth. So how do we know the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth – we go directly to The Way, The Truth and The Life – the only way to God – Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit.
6. **KISS PRINCIPLE: Keep It Simple Saint – Just keep your focus on Christ.** – **Good fight of faith in Jesus Christ.**  
*But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity<sup>[a]</sup> that is in Christ. **2 Corinthians 11:3***  
**God is not asking us to make sure we understand everything, but rather TRUST HIM no matter what!**
