SHIELD OF FAITH AND FIERY DARTS

above all, taking the shield of faith which, you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one.

On a daily basis these “**Fiery Darts**” can come from anywhere and everywhere, especially from the ones closest to us

Those closest to us often fire the hottest darts, **speaking or acting without thinking, causing the most damage**

Fiery Darts and Flaming Arrows

WORDS

- The insensitive un-discerned (unfiltered) words encountered by others
- Words spoken in “jest” or “mocking”
- Arrogant words spoken in judgment, criticism or gossip
- Words from others unaware of where the words might be coming from (i.e. Peter’s rebuke)





Fiery Darts and Flaming Arrows

ACTIONS

- Physical, mental, spiritual abuse
- Insensitive acts like ignoring or ridicule
- Abandonment and rejection
- Events encountered, either intentional or unintentional by someone, that you perceive as hurtful and damaging
- Even the death of a loved one (grief)



Biblical Example: When Jesus was with His apostles predicting his upcoming death. *Peter rebuked his words, saying, “Never, Lord!” He said, “This shall never happen to you.”*

Jesus turned and said to Peter, “Get thee behind me Satan! You are a stumbling block to me; you do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns.” (Matthew 16:22-23) He was not calling Peter, “Satan”; He was referring to the what was behind Peter’s words as he spoke without discernment.





- Those closest to us often fire the hottest darts, speaking or acting without thinking causing the most damage.
- Therefore, we hold up the shield of faith that quenches every fiery dart.



W.O.W. Word of Warning: Our own mouth can be used by the enemy as fiery darts against someone else, or even our self (e.g., self-proclaimed vows or even curses).

WHAT IS FAITH?





NOW **FAITH** is the assurance (the confirmation) of the things [we] hope for, being the **proof of things** [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith **perceiving** as real fact what is not revealed to the senses].

Hebrews 11:1 AMP



In the Bible is story after story of the **Faith Walk** –

Hebrews 11 proclaims

– Ancient Hall of Faith **-FAITH IN ACTION**

Noah and the Ark; Abraham and Sarah receiving a child in old age; Joseph knowing God had a plan for him after many years of overwhelming trials; Moses parting the Red Sea and leading the Israelites out of Egypt, and eventually to the promised land; Joshua taking down the walls of Jericho; Daniel in lion's den; David and Goliath; Ester, Mary, Naomi, Rahab, Ruth, Peter, Paul, the Apostles, etc...





How does this apply to us today? (5 ways)

1. This is a Day-to-Day Walk

*Therefore, do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. **Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.***

Matthew 6:34



How does this apply to us today? (5 ways)

1. This is a Day-to-Day Walk

Then the Lord said to Moses, "I will rain down bread from heaven for you. The people are to go out each day and gather enough for that day. In this way I will test them and see whether they will follow my instructions."

Exodus 16:4





How does this apply to us today?
(5 ways)

1. This is a Day-to-Day Walk

*Trust in the LORD with all your heart and **lean not** on **your own understanding**;*

Proverbs 3:5

How does this apply to us today? (5 ways)

2. Building **“Faith muscles”** – like building our bodies in the natural, building faith spiritually requires resistance, testing, and endurance.

a) No pain, no gain – God may give us more than we can handle because we invariably try to take control. The stretched muscle becomes strong in the time of repair. It is always a question of **SURRENDERING to HIM!**





How does this apply to us today? (5 ways)

2. Building “Faith muscles”

*Count it all joy, my brothers, **when you meet trials of various kinds**, for you know that the **testing of your faith produces steadfastness**. And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.*

James 1:2-4

How does this apply to us today? (5 ways)

2. Building **“Faith muscles”**

- b) God sent us the Holy Spirit to enable us to do ALL He calls us to do. And **nothing is impossible with God!** (Luke 1:37).
- c) We are **NO LONGER SLAVES TO SIN** –to this world, but sons of God through Jesus Christ. Therefore, joint heir with Christ in all the God has for us.





How does this apply to us today? (5 ways)

2. Building **“Faith muscles”**

- d) Stay in the day to day – **stay focused on what is right before you.** Do not drift off by presuming what is going to happen in the future. Keep bringing whatever is on your heart to Christ throughout the day (**Pray without ceasing**).





How does this apply to us today? (5 ways)

2. Building “Faith muscles”

Pray without ceasing...

*Rejoice always and delight in your faith; be **unceasing and persistent in prayer**; in every situation [no matter what the circumstances] be **thankful and continually give thanks to God**; for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus. **Do not quench** [subdue or be unresponsive to the working and guidance of] the [Holy] Spirit.*

1 Thessalonians 5:16-19 AMP

e) The more you learn to trust Christ by leaning on the Holy Spirit in your life, the more you will

How does this apply to us today?
(5 ways)

3. The Wilderness Period – you feel like you are just wandering around with no direction and no help.

a) If you are in the Wilderness period it is usually the time God is waiting for us to come to Him! e.g., Israelites in the dessert and getting to the Promised Land. They were so focused on their problems and needs they lost out on the relationship with God and the Promised land until the next generation.





How does this apply to us today?
(5 ways)

3. The Wilderness Period

- b) It is a time of refinement. There may be parts of your *character that need refining*.
- c) God is often waiting on us, not necessarily us waiting on Him (e.g., drowning victim).



How does this apply to us today?
(5 ways)

3. The Wilderness Period

d) If we hold on in complete trust, the waiting creates a solid steady faith in the Lord which only grows each day.

4. **One percent of faith can move mountains** – faith as tiny as a mustard seed.

a) Story of the noted *Preacher*.

4. One percent of faith can move mountains

So, Jesus said to them, “Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, *if you have faith as a mustard seed*, you will say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.

- b) Remember we are building our faith honed (sharpened) for God's purposes and plan taking down powers and principalities in our own lives, as well as others.

4. One percent of faith can move mountains

- c) Your “catalyst” (person or thing that precipitates an event) is the very means by which we learn and are refined. This is what builds the shield of faith, knowing Christ is with us.

5. Count it all Joy?

- a) As you continue this personal intimate journey with Jesus your perspective changes, **because you are seeing things from the Lord's perspective**—the much bigger picture. You are walking in His Kingdom with a **mind renewed by the Holy Spirit.**



How does this apply to us today? (5 ways)

5. Count it all Joy?

*“Dear brothers and sisters, when troubles come your way, **consider it an opportunity for great joy** (count it all joy). For you know that **when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow**. So let it grow, for **when your endurance is fully developed, you will be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.**”*

James 1:2-4

5. Count it all Joy?

*“Beloved, do not be surprised at the painful trial you are suffering, **as though something strange were happening to you**; but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ’s suffering, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy.”*

b) “Count it all joy” would “*tweak my flesh*” until God began to reveal the bigger picture and changed my perspective – renewed my mind- from the old man to the new man.

- c) **ON A GLOBAL SCALE today** –
The Holy Spirit is bringing us in
unity through our relationship
with Jesus Christ and hearing
His voice taking down powers
and principalities and the spirit of
antichrist coming against us.
